2012 Olympic Project

Terms of Reference

Objectives:

To identify and communicate to the C4B Board, the exceptional business opportunities that the London 2012 Olympic and Paralympic Games provide for Canterbury and the surrounding district.

To work with partners at all levels to create and develop action plans and projects that will support local businesses to prepare themselves and take advantage of the games in a way that will grow the local economy.

To liaise closely with the other C4B working groups to ensure a consistent approach, minimising overlap and maximising our contribution to the community.

Governance:

The working group standing membership should not exceed five members, at least one of whom should be a C4B Board member and one from Canterbury City Council. At least two should be from the private sector. The group should be able to invite additional members on an ad hoc basis to provide specialist knowledge or skills.

The composition of the working group should, wherever possible, represent the whole of the Canterbury area.

The working group should meet at least bi-monthly, or more frequently if required, and report monthly to the C4B Board.

C4B governance on issues of conflict of interest shall apply.
